The post is for one year, starting in August, with the possibility of a second year if suitable.

We provide accommodation and a charitable trust provides an allowance for living expenses. Conferences, courses and expenses are also covered. We ask successful applicants to raise a financial contribution of £7,000 towards the year, and we will be able to help with this fundraising process.

Appointments will be subject to an enhanced DBS check.
